ARSON REWARD

You can help put an end to suspicious fire activity by making an anonymous tip. If the information you provide leads to the arrest and indictment of the suspect(s), you could claim an Arson Reward of up to \$10,000. When you call 888.998.7362 the operator will instruct you not to give your name and assign you a code. You are then asked a series of questions designed to gather information without revealing your identity and the information is passed along to local law enforcement officials for investigation.
